- If anyone feels strongly against a particular image of them or their vessel being shown on the site, we will remove it.

- We may have to crop an image to fit a web page and all images will be compressed to web format.

- We will state at membership meetings, event briefings or on any entry forms, photos will be taken of the event and should people not like their photo to be used on the site to let the committee know.
